#### Kroger Community Rewards Program

Kroger Community Rewards is a way to donate to St. Trinity based on the shopping you do everyday. Once you link your card to St. Trinity, all you have to do is shop at Kroger and swipe your Shopper's Card! A digital account is needed to participate in Community Rewards. Create a digital account by installing the app on your phone and create an account. If you already have a digital account, you will need to ensure you have a Plus Card linked to your account. You must select St. Trinity as the organization you wish to donate to in the app by going to the upper left corner where the 3 horizontal lines are, a dropdown list will display, select Rewards from the list, select Community Rewards, then search for St. Trinity Ev. Lutheran Church & Preschool and once you locate, select it as your organization and select save. Please note, a Shopper's Card is required for the Community Rewards program.
