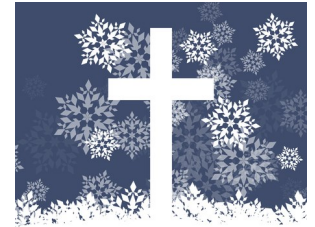

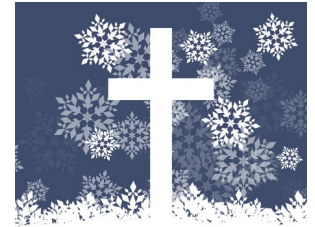
Endowment Fund



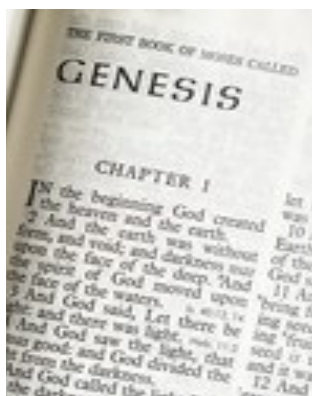
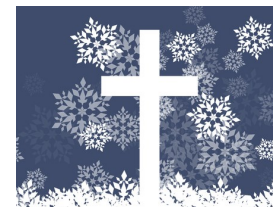

Kroger Community Rewards Program

Kroger Community Rewards is a super easy way to donate to St. Trinity based on the shopping you do everyday. Once you link your shoppers card (&/or your alternate ID) to St. Trinity via your digital account, all you have to do is shop at Kroger and swipe your Shopper's Card! A digital account is required to participate in Community Rewards. Create a digital account by installing the app on your phone and create an account. If you already have a digital account, you will need to ensure you have your current Plus Card &/or Alternate ID linked to your digital account. At the end of creating your account in the app, You must then select the organization you wish to donate to, by going to the upper left corner where the 3 horizontal lines are, a dropdown list will display. Select Rewards from the list, then select Community Rewards & search for "St. Trinity Ev. Lutheran Church & Preschool."

Once you locate us, select us as your organization. It's that simple!

Please note: A Kroger Plus Card digital account is required to participate in the Community Rewards program.
