## Stewardship Corner

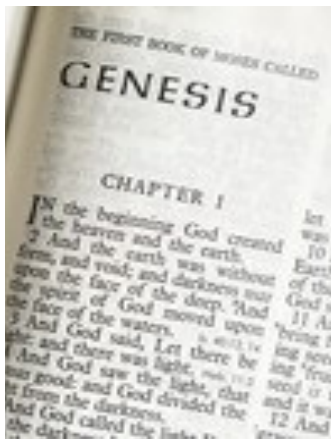
